Today we have the next stage of the RCIA, the 'Rite of Pre-inscription' (a kind of sending off with our prayers) at St John's Church at 9.30am Mass, followed by the 'Rite of Election' at St Mary's Cathedral at 3pm. Prayers are asked for our 3 catechumens (those who have not been baptised), Christopher Umwani, David Wylie and Gary Zoltie, and for Freddie Maclennan Hawkes, our candidate (those baptised into another denomination).

PLANS FOR LENT IN OUR SISTER PARISHES IN THIS JUBILEE 'YEAR OF MERCY'

The season of preparation for Easter began last Wednesday, Ash Wednesday. Each person is invited to begin a Lenten journey – with the following offered as aids on that journey: Why not choose one or two of what's on offer each week?

<u>Each weekday</u> from Monday to Thursday, there is the **Morning Prayer of the Church at 9.30am at St John's**.

There is also the invitation to **join a Lenten house group - t**he house group meets at the same time in the same place each week for around an hour during the 5 middle weeks of Lent, commencing this Monday 15th February. **If you would like to participate in these groups please put your name and phone no. on the lists which can be found at the back of each Church or ring the hosts.**

This year we also intend to offer **Stations of the Cross at 7pm each Wednesday evening**, alternating between St John's and St Mary Magdalene's and led each week by a different parish group.

In addition, there is **our normal weekly timetable** to dip in and out of:

- **Daily Mass** at 10am in the morning (4 times a week at St John's, once a week at St Mary Magdalene's) ... with one evening Mass a week at St Mary Magdalene's at 7pm (normally on a Tuesday).
- **Exposition of the Blessed Sacrament**, on Mondays from 7pm to 8pm at St John's, on Tuesday (normally) from 6.15pm to 7pm at St Mary Magdalene's, and on Friday from 9.15 to 10am at St John's.
- **Divine Mercy Devotions** from 3 to 4pm on Friday at St John's.
- Stations of the Cross after Wednesday morning Mass at St John's led by the Legion of Mary.

In addition to these daily and weekly options, there is also the opportunity to participate in some oneoff events in both the parish and the diocese.

In the parish, there will be:

- **SCIAF Stations of the Cross** on Sunday 28th February at 2.30pm at St John's with 2 visitors from Ethiopia and our own Jim Gallagher, a SCIAF director, who has recently returned from a visit to Ethiopia.
- ... and the opportunity to enjoy a **performance by The Rock Choir** who, by invitation of the St Vincent de Paul conference, will be performing at St John's Church on Saturday 12th March at 2pm.

... while in the Diocese, there will be:

- The Lenten Station Mass with Archbishop Cushley which will take place at St Cuthbert's, Slateford, this Wednesday 17th February, at which our RCIA candidates will be presented with the Creed.
- The annual **Archdiocesan Justice & Peace Lenten Retreat** which will take place at St Catherine's Convent, Lauriston Gardens, Edinburgh, on Saturday 12th March from 10am to 3pm. The theme this year is "Laudato Si" (Caring for Our Common Home), and will be led by Ellen Teague, a well known Catholic writer, journalist and campaigner on justice, peace and ecological issues.

<u>Lent is a time for Reconciliation</u> ... and especially in this Jubilee Year. Pope Francis has asked for a special 24 hours of Reconciliation on Friday & Saturday 4th & 5th March (details to follow). Then, on Sunday 6th March, the 4th Sunday of Lent, **we will celebrate Reconciliation at our Sunday Masses**, with several priests available to celebrate the sacrament.

<u>Lent is also a time for Almsgiving</u>... and for **SCIAF's WEE BOXES**. Please take one home with you. Once again, the UK Government will match £1 for £1 every donation made.

<u>'Sponsored Slim'</u>... an opportunity to support a project in Rwanda by **sponsoring Fr Jock to lose a few pounds!** Sponsor sheets can be found at the back of both churches. (Details of the project in Rwanda will be in next week's newsletter.)
