VOLUNTEERS REQUIRED AT MOUNT VERNON CEMETERY

Anna Kulwicka at the Archdiocesan Offices writes: 'Lair holders, visitors and friends of Mount Vernon - Volunteers are needed for a summer clear up during the month July 2018 (Saturday's) anytime between 10 am and 4 pm. As you will have noticed there is much happening at the cemetery re-levelling of ground; turf repairs, wall repairs; removal of trees and shrubs and general maintenance and numerous test digs. We have 12,800 lairs and at times it is almost impossible to keep on top of general tidy up. we need a team of dedicated volunteers to go round and assist with picking up ornaments, flower holders, plastic bottles, stones, clean memorials (in particular in the older part of the cemetery where there are very few visitors). MAJOR REPAIR TO ROADWAYS AT MOUNT VERNON CEMETERY - FUNDING APPEAL:

Anna Kulwicka writes: 'Lair Holders, relatives and friends of Mount Vernon,

the roadways in the Cemetery are in need of major repair works. The cost for renewing all roadways within the Cemetery is £58,000. The Archdiocese of St Andrews & Edinburgh is a Charity which includes the Catholic Cemetery Mount Vernon, Liberton. Income received from burials and memorial permissions only just covers staff costs and any surplus goes towards ground maintenance costs which are forever on the increase. In the past there was an annual fee payable by each lair holder which assisted towards staff and ground maintenance costs. This has not been the case for many years and it would now be very difficult to reintroduce and administer this charge given that there are 12,800 Lair Holders. We appeal to your generosity and hope that Lair Holders, Relatives and Friends of Mount Vernon will fully support the efforts being made for improvements at the Cemetery. Once work is complete (envisaged taking around 2 weeks) it will totally transform the appearance of the Cemetery. For all those who donate funds towards this project your name will be included a Register of Donors and this will be kept in perpetuity. Please note that donations, cash or cheques, will only be accepted at the Curial Offices based at the Archdiocesan Offices, 100 Strathearn Road, Edinburgh EH9 1BB.

The Present as a Gift

'So much suffering comes from disappointment. We wait for something which we believe will bring us happiness, and it does not arrive.
