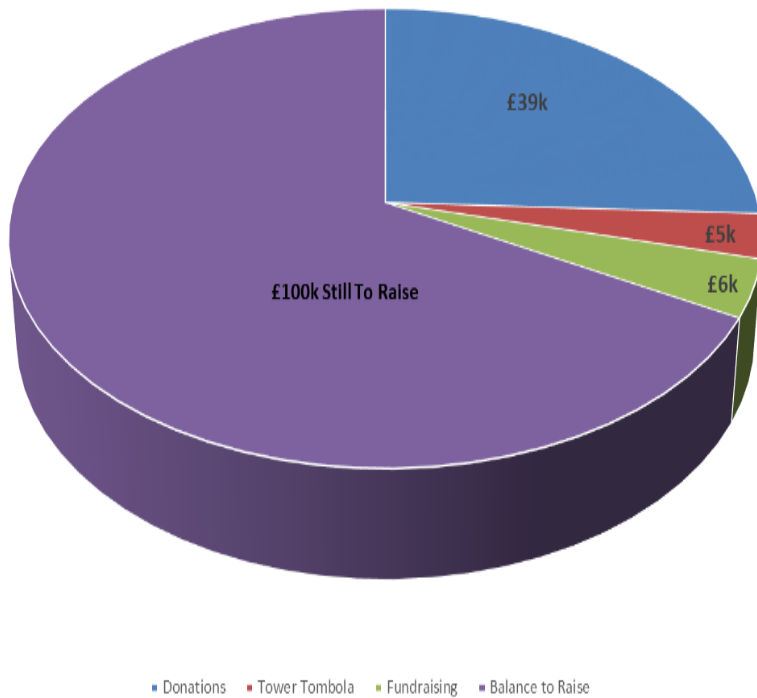


UPDATE ON THE TOWER

Gary Zoltie, Chair of St John's Finance Council writes. 'With the scaffolding now up and the renovation work in full flow we are very happy to announce that we have achieved a key milestone in the fundraising effort. Thank you very much for the continuing donations you have made. The Tower Tombola has been a big success with over one hundred entrants so far and this has delivered an additional £4,500 to our funds already. A reminder that the total project cost is £352,000 and we started with £202,000 in the bank so we have a target to raise £150,000.

In the first nine months since we launched the project, we have raised an **amazing £50,000**. Only another £100,000 to go!!

Whilst we have secured a loan from the Archdiocese for the full £150,000, all funds raised will reduce the amount that we will need to borrow.
