

Gaza Ceasefire Lenten Pilgrimage

This Lent, a global movement is walking in prayerful solidarity with the people of Gaza, from our own home towns. Come walk with us as we walk the entire **Waters of Leith**, on Friday afternoons, during Lent, with a reflection event the week following the last walk. During each walk, there will be moments for prayer for the people of Gaza and also time to connect directly with a group from Bethlehem as they pray the rosary.

Walk 1 – 23rd Feb: 1.30pm Balerno to Slateford – 5 miles (approx)
Meeting point – Balerno High School (serviced by No. 44 bus, journey time approx 20-25 mins from Haymarket)

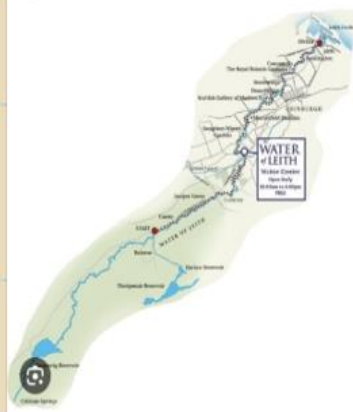
Walk 2 – 1st March: 1.30 pm Slateford to Stockbridge – 4 miles (approx)
Meeting point – Water of Leith Visitor Centre (serviced by No.44 bus, journey time approx 10 mins from Haymarket)

Walk 3 – 8th March: 1.30pm Stockbridge to Leith – 3.5 miles (approx)
Meeting point – end location of walk 2 (Stockbridge serviced by several buses to city centre)

Reflection - 15th March: 1.30pm St John the Baptist Parish Church

For those who wish, refreshments can hopefully be purchased at the end of each walk. Alternatively, feel free to bring your own snacks & drinks.

NB: All participants take part entirely at their own risk. This walk is largely on flat ground and on pathways. Please see <https://www.waterofleith.org.uk> for more information.
